## **.Articles.**

- Bio Write-ups, inspirational reads can be from 300 to 500-word count.
- Tutorials should include a list of complete materials followed by detailed instructions in bullet point format.
- All write-ups can be submitted as Word Documents or PDF format.
- Include your name, email, website, blog or social media ID.

## **.Photos.**

- Varied photos to accompany articles are required. Use the opportunity to shine here. Submit as many photos as you see fit to accompany your write-up. Minimum of 5.
- If it is a tutorial or how to, consider including process shots of the project and photo of finished project nicely displayed.
- Photos can be edited or non-edited. Professionally edited photos should include credit to the photographer respectively.
- Include high resolution photos. Minimum of 75 pixels/inch.
- Note: Photos will be kept on file for future use of the publication such as marketing and calendars.

## **.Prospective Publishing Dates and themes.**

- April/ Spring theme/ Submissions due by March 14th
- August/ Fall, Halloween theme/ Submissions due by July 11th
- November/ Thanksgiving, Christmas theme/ Submissions due by October 1st.
